ORMOND PARTNER POLICY (MCR)

Purpose

Members of Ormond College's Middle Common Room may seek permission from the College to bring a long-term partner into residence with them.

While partners are not required to meet all of the conditions and expectations that apply to members of the College, they will be living in the Ormond Community and are expected to live within the College values and engage positively with all members of the Ormond community.

The partners of members of the College are expected to:

- know and understand the College values and what they mean for the way life is lived in the College
- ensure that their conduct is compatible with the College values, which includes:
 - interacting respectfully and positively with students, tutors and staff of the College
 - negotiating calmly with staff and members of the College to resolve any issues that arise
- refer any concerns about student behaviour or wellbeing to the Vice Master
- behave in a manner that reflects well on the College at all College events
- comply with all health and safety procedures or directions.

Partners of members of the MCR are eligible for meals in Hall in accordance with the meal plan they have entered into. Additional meals are charged at a cost of \$12.00 per meal.

They are also welcome to attend all open learning events (including lectures, workshops and faculty-based events) offered by the College. Partners are not eligible to attend Student Club, JCR, MCR or SCR events unless invited by the office-bearers of the respective Common Rooms.
