



## Fee Schedule - Graduate Residents 2026

The 2026 Graduate fee includes accommodation in a furnished bedroom for;

- 50 weeks of the year for returning Graduate students, and
- 48 weeks of the year for new Graduate students.

College fees also include the Learning programs, leadership programs, internet usage, information services, sports facilities, a fitness membership with Melbourne University Sport, and music practice studio. A comprehensive range of graphic, printing & photocopying resources are provided in the Academic Centre. Printing is charged on a user pay basis.

The College provides 3 meals daily, and a brunch offering on Sundays.

**Fees will be billed in 10 equal monthly instalments (February - November). Payment of the monthly instalment is due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month billed. Late payment fees are charged at 12% per annum. This document is to be read in conjunction with the Graduate Residential Offer for 2026.**

The cost of the MCR subscription fee will be \$400 incl. GST per annum for 2026.<sup>1</sup></li><li>• Ormond College Students' Club (OCSC) subscription fee will be \$56.70 incl. GST per annum for 2026<sup>1</sup></li><li>• Car Parking \$687.50 per semester incl. GST. Very limited spots available. An application for a car park spot is required with the decision to be made by College management.<sup>2</sup></li><li>• A Voluntary Tax-Deductible Donation of \$300 to the Ormond College Building Fund (DGR) will help conserve the beauty and heritage of our beloved campus while also enhancing our learning spaces and facilities.
